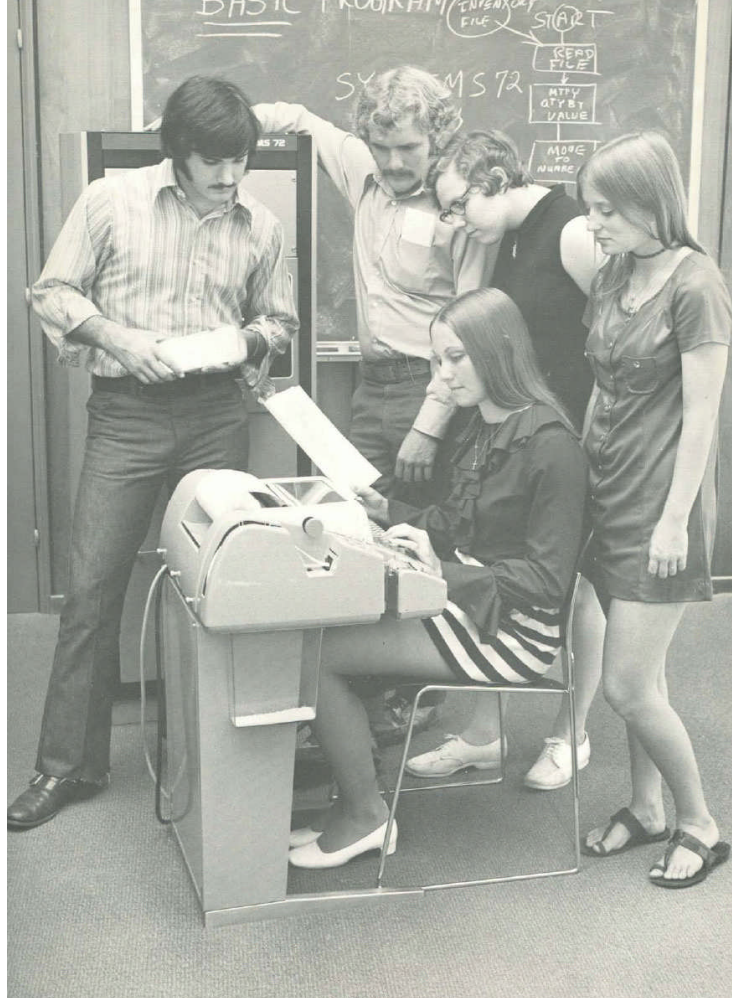


Getting to Eighth and Sycamore
